2007 Borseth Sewer Project

Gentlepersons:

The City of Sedro-Woolley is requesting quotes through the Small Works Roster Pool to connect three homes to the City sanitary sewer. Work will also included providing a side service to a garage on West State Street. The addresses are 820 Borseth, 822 Borseth, 310 W. State Street and two neighboring lots to the east of 310 West State. The homes with Borseth addresses have a side sewer stub and clean out already provided. The Contractor will be responsible for intercepting the sewer line and connecting it to the provided stub.

This contract provides for the improvements of approximately 330 lineal feet of 6-inch sanitary sewer line off of West State and Borseth Street, Sedro-Woolley, Washington. Work will also include, but is not limited to locating, disconnecting, plugging the existing force main and sewer that perforates the sump, installation of sanitary sewer clean outs, pothole and locate the provided stubs, and restoration of disturbed areas, all in accordance with the Contract Documents.

Bid award will likely take place within 30 days of the date of closing, with Notice to Proceed following award, and being within 10 days of receiving all necessary paperwork.
