



INVITATION TO BID

2008 Alexander Street Improvement Curb and Gutter Project

The City of Sedro-Woolley is soliciting bids under the city's Small Works Roster process for installation of approximately 402 linear feet (LF) of straight cement curb and gutter adjacent to three storm catch basins and a concrete driveway entrance. The sidewalk and driveway are to be done by others. The location is on the south side of Alexander Street and 5th Street. Information on the project, bid form, contract forms, and technical specifications may be viewed on the city's website at www.ci.sedro-woolley.wa.us/BidsAwards/main.htm.

The grading and preparation work will be done by the City of Sedro-Woolley. Starting from the west side of the project, the 402 LF distance includes approximately 24 feet to the first Type 1 storm catch basin (CB), 120 feet to a Type 1L CB which includes a 6" reducer to equal a Type 1 cover, 170 LF feet to the start of a Type 1 Cement Concrete driveway entrance and ending at 206 LF, then 40 LF to the third Type 1 CB and 10 linear feet from the end of the project. The concrete driveway work includes only the curb and gutter and shall center an existing gate at the property. The sidewalks and driveway are to be done by others.

If a curb machine is to be used, to accommodate the curb machine's travel, the City will match the requirements for your machine. The City will locate the top of the basin no more than 13" from top Back of Curb. As another measure, the City will leave 8 inches from the flow line to the top of the riser. The existing catch basin risers will not be mudded until the curb is ran out. The city will mud the deeper part of the catch basins but wait on the top sections. The standard WSDOT detail shows a 6" high gutter and 6" high curb (=12"). You may reference the WSDOT detail F-10.12-00 for more information regarding the curb and gutter. You may reference the WSDOT detail F-80.10-00 for more information regarding the cement concrete drive entrance

Lump Sum bid shall include total construction costs, including tax. Also note:

- Prevailing wage laws apply
- Bidder shall register or maintain registration on the MRSC Consultant Roster
- Prior to award, the lowest, responsive, responsible bidder shall have or obtain a City of Sedro-Woolley business license
