

INVITATION FOR BID  
CITY OF SEDRO-WOOLLEY  
**SR-9 SEWER EXTENSION PROJECT**

Sealed bid proposals will be received by the City of Sedro-Woolley, at Sedro-Woolley City Hall, 325 Metcalf Street, Sedro-Woolley, Washington, 98284, (360) 855-1661, until 2:00 p.m. on May 14, 2010, and will then and there be opened and publicly read for installation of approximately 1350 lineal feet of sanitary sewer along STATE ROUTE 9 from Alderwood Lane to Bassett Road in Sedro-Woolley, Washington.

This work shall consist of approximately 493 lineal feet of 8" diameter PVC pipe; if funding allows, then the City has the option to construct an additional 537 lineal feet (1030 LF total) of 8" PVC sewer pipe. Work for this sanitary sewer system shall include, but is not limited to, manholes, connection to existing sewer pipe, clearing and grubbing, and surface restoration. This project will also require; 46 lineal feet of 18" diameter steel casing installed trenchlessly under SR-9. All work shall be performed in accordance with the Contract Plans, Special Provisions, the Standard Specifications and Standard Plans. All materials, equipment, labor, and other miscellaneous items required to complete the work, shall be furnished by the contractor.

All bid proposals shall be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit in cash, certified check, cashier's check, or surety bond in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the amount of such bid proposal. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish satisfactory performance bond and payment bond both in an amount of 100 percent (100%) of the contract price within the time stated in the specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to the City of Sedro-Woolley. All bidders shall have a contractor's license to work in the State of Washington. Upon award, the successful bidder and subcontractors shall obtain or provide proof of holding a current *City of Sedro-Woolley Business License*.

Maps, plans, and specifications may be obtained from the City of Sedro-Woolley Engineering Department upon payment in the amount of **\$35.00** for specifications and plan sets. If requesting that plans and specification be express shipped, add **\$16.00** to payment. Plans and Specifications will be available on **April 21, 2010, after 3:00 p.m. at the City of Sedro-Woolley Engineering Department, 325 Metcalf Street, Sedro-Woolley, Washington, 98284**. Informational copies of maps, plans and specifications will be on file for inspection at the City of Sedro-Woolley Engineering Department, 325 Metcalf Street, Sedro-Woolley, Washington 98284.
