



## **SR 20/Puget Ave Emergency Vehicle Traffic Control Signal Basic Operations:**

### **What drivers on SR 20 will see:**

Under normal circumstances, eastbound and westbound drivers will see flashing yellow lights.

When the signal is activated, the flashing yellow lights will turn to solid yellow lights, similar to the yellow before red at a normal traffic signal.

After the solid yellow lights, the lights will turn solid red, indicating both directions of SR20 traffic to stop at the stop bars. In addition to the red lights, eastbound drivers will see a lighted sign with a no right turn symbol onto Puget Ave. This is to allow an emergency vehicle approaching SR 20 on Puget Ave to go around vehicles that may be stopped on Puget Ave waiting to turn onto SR 20.

After the emergency vehicles have gone through the intersection, the lights will turn from solid red back to flashing yellow and the lighted no right turn symbol sign will go off, indicating traffic may again move through the intersection normally.

### **What the drivers on Puget Ave will see:**

Drivers on Puget will see flashing red lights under normal circumstances as well as when the emergency signal is activated. The intersection for Puget drivers remains a stop controlled intersection.
