**NOTICE OF UPCOMING STREET IMPROVEMENTS
ON HEATHER LANE**

Dear Resident,

This letter is to inform you of an upcoming City project in your neighborhood. The planned work will include asphalt repair work on Heather Lane the **week of September 21st**. This work is being done to correct the areas in the center of the street that have settled over time and are now collecting rain water which is causing the street to deteriorate and form pot holes.

Note: This work is weather dependent, and may be cancelled at the last minute due to wet weather.

We would greatly appreciate it if residents would **not park on the street** during the **week of September 21st**. City personnel will assist residents with getting in and out of their driveways during this time.

It is important to note that this patch work is only a temporary fix intended to correct the drainage issues so that we no longer have standing water in the middle of Heather Lane. Crews will perform this temporary repair the week of September 21st, and then work will cease for the remainder of 2015.

In the spring of 2016, crews will return to finish repairing the low areas and pot holes in the street. Then in August of 2016, the city will contract with Skagit County Public Works to apply what is known as a chip seal coating to the road surface which will level out any imperfections, and apply a wear surface that will protect the street from potholes. Chip sealing consists of spraying a layer of road oil to the street surface; a layer of gravel is then applied on top of the oil and then rolled into the oil. The surface is then allowed to cure for approximately two weeks and then excess rock is swept away.

Please feel free to contact us with any questions. Also, please let us know if you have any special access needs that we should be aware of. We know that this will be an inconvenience for you so we want to do what we can to minimize that.
