Free TV, Computer and Monitor Recycling at Sedro-Woolley!

The electronics recycling program is an on-going program and is paid for by electronic manufacturers. More information is available at: <https://ecology.wa.gov/Waste-Toxics/Reducing-recycling-waste/Electronics>

What's included in the program?

Computers, computer monitors, televisions, and other electronics that contain CRT's (Cathode ray tubes) computer circuit boards contain hazardous materials such as lead, cadmium and mercury. Electronics are no longer accepted for landfill disposal at Skagit County facilities. These changes are in response to Washington State Department of Ecology, Skagit County Health Department and Federal rules.

The City of Sedro-Woolley recycling site:

Will be accepting televisions including flat screens, computers and monitors including flat screens at no charge thanks to manufacturers who will be covering the cost for recycling these products.

Other electronics are also accepted for free, at our site but are not a part of the State of WA state program. These include vacuums, radios, phones, printers, copiers, speakers, cameras, modems, remote controls, small electric heaters, and battery operated weed eaters.

The Take it Bank Network, currently provides several other recycling options for these products.

- Contact a recycler based in Skagit County. Call ahead to ask for prices and to check for any restrictions on materials collected.
- Check with major retailers and manufacturers for reuse and recycling programs.
