Free TV, Computer and Monitor Recycling Begins January 1, 2009 at Recycle Site in Sedro-Woolley!

A new electronics recycling program will begin January 1, 2009. This permanent, on-going program is paid for by electronic manufacturers. More information is available at <http://ecyclewashington.org/>. See you in January.

Computers, computer monitors, televisions, and other electronics that contain CRT's (cathode ray tubes), and separated computer circuit boards contain hazardous materials such as lead, cadmium and mercury. They are no longer accepted for landfill disposal at Skagit County facilities. This change is in response to Washington State Department of Ecology, Skagit County Health District and Federal rules.

You now have many options for recycling computers, monitors, televisions, and some other electronics in the City. Beginning January 1, 2009 the City of Sedro-Woolley recycling site will be accepting televisions, computers and monitors at no charges thanks to manufacturers who will be covering the cost for recycling. The Take it Bank Network currently provides several recycling options for these products.

- Contact a recycler based in Skagit County. Call ahead to ask for prices and to check for any restrictions on materials collected.
- Check with major retailers and manufacturers for reuse and recycling programs.
