

## What do I do with...? Old Paint

**Latex paint** If you have excess latex paint you can either use it up or open your can and let it dry out then throw it away in the garbage you can add sand, cat litter or dirt to your paint to help it dry quicker. (See below for example pictures)

**Enamel paint** If you have excess enamel based paint you should bring this in for recycling. Please take it to the Skagit County Transfer site on Ovenell Road or you may call us.

**Stains and Thinners:** If you have excess of Stain or thinners you should bring this in for recycling. Please take it to the Skagit County Transfer site on Ovenell Road.

**Aerosols: (empty)** Aerosols include paints, pesticides, solvent cleaners, and oven cleaners. Low toxicity products that are typically used for beauty and hygiene uses (hair sprays, shaving creams, deodorants, etc.), and empty aerosol cans may be disposed of in the garbage.

Used paintbrushes, rollers and empty paint cans treat as garbage unless the containers are washed, then recycle it in your normal recycling.
