Dear Property Owner,

The City has received funding for construction of the SR20, Metcalf Street to Township Street Lane Widening and Pedestrian/Bicycle Improvement Project. At this time the project is in the preliminary design stage. The project consists of the addition of a center turn lane between Ball Street and Reed Street, along with curbs, gutters, sidewalks, bike lanes, relocation of the pedestrian crossing from Central Street to Reed Street, pavement markings, streetscape improvements and enhanced illumination. We anticipate advertising for bids in May of 2011, with construction to start in early July, and complete by the end of the year.

We have scheduled a public information meeting from 5:30 to 7:00 pm on Tuesday, February 1, 2011 at the City of Sedro-Woolley Council Chambers, 325 Metcalf Street. Representatives of the City, the design engineer and the Washington State Department of Transportation will be present to describe the improvements, discuss construction sequencing and to address questions. Displays showing the proposed road section will be available for review. You are invited to stop by and find out about this exciting City project.
