



## SR20/F&S Grade Road & Skagit Industrial Park Roadway Improvement Project

### NOTICE OF UPCOMING CONSTRUCTION WORK

Dear Bingham Park Area Resident,

The City of Sedro-Woolley is currently working with Interwest Construction, Inc. and David Evans and Associates, Inc. to construct the SR20/ F&S Grade Road and Skagit Industrial Park Roadway Improvement Project. The project consists of roadway widening and intersection improvements on F&S Grade Road and construction of a single-lane roundabout on SR20 north of the Skagit Industrial Park. Upon successful completion of this project, access to businesses and manufacturing sites in the area will be improved and traffic circulation and safety will be enhanced along SR20 and the F&S Grade road corridor. The access to W. Moore Street directly from SR20 will also be removed and redirected to F&S Grade Road.

Beginning on or after June 4, 2009, Interwest Construction, Inc. will be delivering soils material excavated from the F&S Grade Road and SR20 project site to the northern portion of Bingham Park for stockpiling and future use. The haul route for this material will be south along SR20 to the junction with Munro St. then west along Munro St. to the Bingham Park stockpile location. To facilitate access to Munro St. from SR20, Interwest Construction will remove a portion of the dirt berm and landscaping currently blocking the east end of Munro St. This temporary access will be signed and barricaded and is intended solely for construction traffic. No local access from this point will be granted. At the conclusion of the materials delivery period which is expected to last until early September 2009, the dirt berm will be reconstructed and the area will be restored to its current condition.

The increased construction traffic related to this work will be limited to the regular working hours for this project which are currently Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Area residents will be informed of any changes to this schedule or other aspects of this work and every effort will be made to maintain a safe and functional environment for all parties. To prevent unnecessary conflicts, please ensure that vehicles and any personal property items are located outside of the Munro St. travel lanes. Access to your residence will be maintained at all times.
