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SR 20 lane closed for two weeks in Sedro-Woolley for roundabout construction

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SEDRO-WOOLLEY: Crews will close one lane of SR 20 through Sedro-Woolley for two weeks in September to finish building a new roundabout near the Skagit Industrial Park.

Crews will close the eastbound lane of SR 20 from 4 a.m., Sept. 9, to 5 p.m., Sept. 22, between Cook Road and Metcalf Street. Flaggers and officers will help detour traffic around the closure via W. Ferry Street and Metcalf Street.

While the eastbound lane is closed, crews will build the north-central portion of the roundabout and install and extend utilities. Local access to F&S Grade Road and adjacent residences and businesses will be maintained during the detour.

The City of Sedro-Woolley is working with Interwest Construction, Inc. and David Evans and Associates, Inc. to construct the SR20/ F&S Grade Road and Skagit Industrial Park Roadway Improvement Project. The project consists of roadway widening and intersection improvements on F&S Grade Road and construction of a single-lane roundabout on SR20 north of the Skagit Industrial Park. Upon successful completion of this project, access to businesses and manufacturing sites in the area will be improved and traffic circulation and safety will be enhanced along SR20 and the F&S Grade road corridor. The access to W. Moore Street directly from SR20 will also be removed and redirected to F&S Grade Road.
