



**FRUITDALE ROAD & McGARIGLE ROAD & SR 9
PEDESTRIAN/BICYCLE SAFETY AND ROAD
IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT**

NOTICE OF UPCOMING CONSTRUCTION WORK

This flyer is being sent to notify you of likely increased traffic on Carter Street due to the construction work taking place this year on Fruitdale Road and McGarigle Road. For the next three weeks, until school closes for the summer on June 16, you will notice increased school bus traffic due to the closure of Fruitdale Road between SR 20 and McGarigle Road. Other Fruitdale through traffic is being routed to SR 9 and McGarigle during this period. After June 16, work will also start on McGarigle between SR 9 and Carter, and a detour route will commence for local McGarigle traffic (between Carter and Fruitdale) using Carter Street. Other information on the project follows.

Starting the week of June 1, Fruitdale Road, between SR 20 and McGarigle Road will be completely reconstructed by G.G Excavation of Anacortes, the General Contractor for the project. This reconstruction includes road grade revisions for drainage, installation of roadway drainage systems, sanitary sewer system, curbs, gutters and walks.

Starting on Tuesday, June 2nd, Fruitdale Road between SR 20 and McGarigle Road will be closed to through traffic as the contractor prepares to pulverize the existing pavement on Fruitdale Road in this vicinity. The pulverized pavement material will be left in place and graded to provide a driving surface. Southbound Fruitdale Road through traffic will be detoured to McGarigle Road and SR 9/Township for access to SR 20, and northbound Fruitdale Road traffic from SR 20 will be detoured to SR 9/Township and McGarigle Road. Fruitdale Road will remain open for local and emergency traffic on a limited basis. Delays may be expected. The Contractor will notify individual residents at least 48 hours in advance of temporary driveway closures during the course of the work.
