



**FRUITDALE ROAD & McGARIGLE ROAD & SR 9
PEDESTRIAN/BICYCLE SAFETY AND ROAD
IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT**

NOTICE OF UPCOMING CONSTRUCTION WORK

This news release regards road closures and detours for the above project.

State Route 9 (SR9) construction activity will add curb, gutter, sidewalks and drainage structures on the west side from June 15 to late August, North of SR20 to Lucas Drive. SR9 will have lanes shifted slightly to the east to allow work to proceed safely and efficiently. Periodic one way traffic with flagger control may be expected.

On June 18 (after school closes for the summer), construction work will start on McGarigle between SR 9 and Carter Street. McGarigle will be closed to through traffic with local access and emergency access only. Construction includes road grade revisions for drainage, installation of roadway drainage systems, sanitary sewer system, curbs, gutters and sidewalks.

Fruitdale Road from SR20 to McGarigle was previously closed to through traffic and will remain open for local and emergency traffic only. Due to the McGarigle and Fruitdale Road closures, those residents living north of the intersection of McGarigle and Fruitdale should use Fruitdale to Kalloch Road, for access to SR9. Those areas include the neighborhoods in the Portobello area, Wildflower (North of Portobello), Northern States, and from Southbound Fruitdale Rd (at Kalloch Road). Northbound Fruitdale Road traffic from SR 20 will be detoured to SR 9/Township to Kalloch Road.

The Contractor will notify individual residents at least 48 hours in advance of temporary driveway closures during the course of the work.
