



INVITATION TO BID

205 N Reed Stump Removal, Tub Grinding and Structure Demolition

The City of Sedro-Woolley is soliciting bids under its Limited Public Works Process for stump removal, tub grinding and demolition of a small structure at 205 North Reed, Sedro-Woolley. The estimated value of this work is under \$5,000.

Instructions to Bidders: This job will consist of excavating and removing approximately 30 alder stumps varying from 8” to 24” in diameter, consolidating three brush piles approximately 30’ x 30’ and tub grinding the stumps and brush piles. Grindings shall be retained on site. Backfill of stump excavations will be accomplished by others. The work also includes demolition and loading of a 20’ x 30’ residential structure with concrete foundation and loading of same into city supplied demolition boxes with disposal by others. Work to be performed in accordance with state and local guidelines. Bids shall include total costs including labor, Washington State sales tax, obtaining necessary licenses and permits (local and/or state), and all equipment necessary to safely complete the job, including mobilization, demobilization and cleanup. State prevailing wage rates per Washington State Department of Labor and Industries are required. Contractors must be registered contractors at time of bid, have a current UBI number, have industrial insurance coverage as verified by WA L&I, have an Employment Security Department number, have a WA state Excise Tax Registration Number, and must not be disqualified from bidding per the Debarred Contractors list. Successful bidder must have or shall obtain a Sedro-Woolley business license. Bidder shall register or maintain registration on the MRSC Consultant Roster at <http://www.mrscrosters.org> prior to award.

Interested contractors are to submit a completed **Bid Proposal** form, **Statement of Bidder’s Qualifications** and **Hourly Rate Sheet**. A bid bond is not required for this project.

Lump sum Proposals are due by 2 pm on Thursday, July 9, 2015.
