REQUEST FOR STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS
PROFESSIONAL SERVICES SOLICITATION

The City of Sedro-Woolley is inviting statements of qualifications and performance information from firms interested in providing professional engineering services for the City of Sedro-Woolley's **Fruitdale Road Arterial Improvements Project**. This project involves design for reconstruction of the city portions of Fruitdale Road from Portobello Avenue to the north City Limits, and for the Skagit County portions of Fruitdale Road from the City Limits to Kalloch Road, and on Kalloch Road from Fruitdale to SR9. The improvements within the city limits generally consist of upgrading 1,400 lineal feet of roadway from Portobello to Wildflower Way including grading, drainage, curbs, gutters, asphalt pavement, sidewalks, pavement markings, signage, illumination, and a roundabout intersection at Fruitdale and Northern States Road. The work within the city also includes upgrading 1,200 lineal feet of Fruitdale from Wildflower Way to the north City Limits to realign the roadway out of a slide prone zone and to add shoulders, and addition of sidewalks on the east side of Fruitdale from McGarigle to Portobello. The improvements within the county portion generally consist of upgrading 3,500 lineal feet of Fruitdale Road and 900 lineal feet of Kalloch Road by shoulder widening where needed and intersection improvements at Fruitdale and Kalloch and at Kalloch and SR9, including grading, HMA and pavement markings.

Responses are due at the Public Works Director's office in Sedro-Woolley City Hall at 325 Metcalf Street, Sedro-Woolley, WA 98284 by 2 pm, November 5, 2015.

Qualification and performance statements will be reviewed according to the City of Sedro-Woolley's Guidelines for Consultant Selection.
