REQUEST FOR STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS
PROFESSIONAL SERVICES SOLICITATION – AMENDMENT 1

The City of Sedro-Woolley is inviting statements of qualifications and performance information from firms interested in providing miscellaneous professional engineering support services for the following two projects; **City of Sedro-Woolley Cascade Trail West Extension Phase 1A –Trail Road to SR9 South (STPUS-0020(181) and Phase 1B – Hodgin Road to Trail Road (TAP-0020(183))**. The city is self-performing the design work for these projects, and is requesting proposals for support services including environmental permitting, topographic and construction surveying, and ~~geotechnical engineering~~ construction materials inspection and testing. Final design work is scheduled to start in November 2015, with completion by May 2016. Construction work for Phase 1A is scheduled for June through December 2016.

The environmental work consists of preparation of the Environmental Classification Summary and any permit applications identified in the ECS for both projects. The surveying work includes minor additions to previously completed topographic surveys for both projects, plus construction surveying for ~~the Phase 1A project only~~ both projects. The geotechnical work consists of construction testing and documentation for the ~~Phase 1A~~ both projects only.

The Projects consists of storm drainage modifications and a 10' wide concrete shared use path improvements on the north side of SR20. Phase 1A is from SR9 South to Trail Road totaling 1,520 lineal feet, and is funded for design and construction. Phase 1B is from Trail Road to Hodgin Road totaling 1,540 lineal feet, ~~and is funded for design only~~. The alignment is generally within the existing grassed swale or paved driveway area north of SR20, including road crossings at Trail Road and Raby Lane.

Interested parties should respond with a Statement of Qualifications. ~~Environmental and Geotechnical firms should also provide estimates for man-hours and classifications needed to complete the project.~~ Responses are due at the Public Works Director's office in Sedro-Woolley City Hall at 325 Metcalf Street, Sedro-Woolley, WA 98284 by **2 pm, November 12, 2015**.

Qualification and performance statements will be reviewed according to the City of Sedro-Woolley's Guidelines for Consultant Selection. Selection will be based on written responses only.
