



REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS 2016 Local Access Street Crack Seal Project

The City of Sedro-Woolley is soliciting proposals for the crack sealing of various local access streets in the City of Sedro-Woolley Washington, 98284.

Instructions to Bidders: Contractor shall clean all cracks and joints ¼" and greater in width with a stiff-bristled broom and compressed air and then shall be filled completely with sand slurry. The sand slurry shall consist of approximately 20 percent CSS-1 emulsified asphalt, approximately 2 percent Portland cement, water (if required), and the remainder clean No. 4-0 paving sand. The components shall be thoroughly mixed and then poured into the cracks and joints until full. The following day, any cracks or joints that are not completely filled shall be topped off with additional sand slurry. After the sand slurry is placed, the filler shall be struck off flush with the existing pavement surface and allowed to cure. Contractor shall be responsible for all traffic control. City will assist with public notices and project coordination.

Approximate LF of the Cracks to be sealed is 6,000 LF.

Streets planned for crack sealing include Brickyard Blvd, Creek Lane, Brick Lane, Cedar Tree Drive, Longtime Lane, Sauk Mountain Drive, Cultus Mountain Drive, Mountain Drive, Summer Meadows Court and Presidio Place.

Proposals shall include total costs including freight, labor and materials, obtaining necessary licenses and permits (local and/or state), and all equipment necessary to safely complete the job, disposal of all related waste and cleanup of the site. Materials and Construction provided for this project will be per City of Sedro-Woolley Public Works Department Standards and the current edition of the Standard Specifications for Road, Bridge and Municipal Construction. State prevailing wage rates per Washington State Department of Labor and Industries are required. Contractors must be registered contractors at time of bid, have a current UBI number, have industrial insurance coverage as verified by WA L&I, have an Employment Security Department number, have a WA state Excise Tax Registration Number, and must not be disqualified from bidding per the Debarred Contractors list. Successful bidder must have or shall obtain a Sedro-Woolley business license. Bidder shall register or maintain registration on the MRSC Consultant Roster at <http://www.mrscrosters.org> prior to award.
