



REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

2017 N. TOWNSHIP STORM LINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT

The City of Sedro-Woolley is soliciting bids through the small works roster process for the replacement of 370 LF of failed Storm Sewer pipe and the installation of 3 - Type 1 catch basins. The approximate shoulder work location is 919 N Township Street in front of the State Department of Natural Resources Northwest Division Headquarters.

Instructions to Bidders: The Contractor shall complete the work according to the following specifications. The existing pipe is 12" corrugated metal. Contractor shall sawcut and remove asphalt and excavate down to the pipe which is approximately 3' deep. Contractor shall remove and dispose of the existing corrugated metal pipe, removed noted catch basins and excavated materials and replace with 12" corrugated polyethylene plastic pipe with smooth interior and gasketed joints. Contractor shall install 3 - Type 1 catch basins with Standard, locking grates, replacing the existing catch basins and connect noted existing pipes to the new structures. Contractor shall furnish pipe bedding and backfill materials, backfill and compact trench, and asphalt pave the trench cut and seal the edges with liquid asphalt. Materials and Construction provided for this project shall be per City of Sedro-Woolley Public Works Department Standards and the current edition of the Standard Specifications for Road, Bridge and Municipal Construction and project drawings. Township Storm Line Replacement Project**. Contractor shall ensure access to the Department of Natural Resources during construction.

Contractor shall be responsible for furnishing all traffic control flagging and devices to complete the project. Because this project is on the shoulder of State Route 9, the successful contractor shall submit a traffic control plan to the City Engineer for approval. A WSDOT permit is not required for this work.

*Contractor shall verify all measurements and quantities.

All work must be completed prior to November 24, 2017.

Engineers estimate range for the project is \$20,000 to \$25,000.

Proposals shall include total costs including freight, labor and materials, obtaining necessary licenses and permits (local and/or state), and all equipment necessary to safely complete the job, disposal of all removed materials, related waste and cleanup and restoration of the site. State prevailing wage rates per Washington State Department of Labor and

Contractors must be registered contractors at time of bid, have a current UBI number, have industrial insurance coverage as verified by WA L&I, have an Employment Security Department number, have a WA state Excise Tax Registration Number, and must not be disqualified from bidding per the Debarred Contractors list. Successful bidder must have or shall obtain a Sedro-Woolley business license. Bidder shall register or maintain registration on our MRSC Rosters Small Works Roster at <http://www.mrscrosters.org> prior to award.

Proposals are due by **2 pm on Tuesday, October 3, 2017**.
