



INVITATION TO BID 2017 On-Call Drainage Ditch Mowing

The City of Sedro-Woolley is soliciting bids for drainage ditch mowing at various locations in the City of Sedro-Woolley. The estimated value of this work is under \$30,000.

Instructions to Bidders: This job will consist of mowing and cleaning of city drainage ditch facilities per this Invitation to Bid and the Bid Proposal Special Provisions in accordance with state and local guidelines. Removed material from either trimming or removal operations that is not chipped and applied onsite will become the property of the contractor and be disposed of in a legal manner. A detailed list of the locations and approximate footage to be maintained along with typical photographs are available on line at City of Sedro-Woolley Web Site at http://www.ci.sedro-woolley.wa.us/resources/bids_and_awards/index.php. Additional trimming or removal may be assigned by Task Order over the course of the year 2017. Special provisions for the work are included on the Proposal Form.

Bids shall include total costs including labor, Washington State sales tax, obtaining necessary licenses and permits (local and/or state), and all equipment necessary to safely complete the job, including traffic control, disposal of any material not chipped and applied on site, along with cleanup of the site.

State prevailing wage rates per Washington State Department of Labor and Industries are required. Contractors must be registered contractors at time of bid, have a current UBI number, have industrial insurance coverage as verified by WA L&I, have an Employment Security Department number, have a WA state Excise Tax Registration Number, and must not be disqualified from bidding per the Debarred Contractors list. Successful bidder must have or shall obtain a Sedro-Woolley business license. Bidder shall register or maintain registration on the MRSC Consultant Roster at <http://www.mrscrosters.org> prior to award. A bid bond is not required for this project.

Bids are due by **2 pm on Tuesday, May 9, 2017**.
