



REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

2018 Senior Center Painting Project

The City of Sedro-Woolley is soliciting bids through the small works roster process for the interior painting of two restrooms and a commercial kitchen. Also included in this RFP is the staining of the outside of a portion of the senior center facility that is made up of peeled logs and other exposed wood. The Senior Center is located at: 715 Pacific Street, Sedro-Woolley, WA

Instructions to Bidders: Proposals should include the cleaning, pressure washing of the exterior portion of the building, and any other prep work required. The peeled logs and soffits will receive a stain seal. The interior restrooms and kitchen will be prepped and painted taking care not to damage restroom fixtures and/or kitchen equipment.

Proposals should be submitted according to the below specifications:

1. Stain/Sealer Product Shall be Sikkens Cetol SRD, color is Cedar. (Exterior)
2. Paint product shall be interior Grade Satin sheen, color TBD. (Interior)

*Please see attached photos of the all of the work areas.

Public works staff will also close off the area to the public during the sealer application. Public works staff will work with senior center director, and contractor to schedule the work so that it does not interphase with normal operations of the Senior Center.

Bids shall include total costs including labor and materials, obtaining necessary licenses and permits (local and/or state), and all equipment necessary to safely complete the job, disposal of all related waste and cleanup of the site.

Contractors must be registered contractors at time of bid, have a current UBI number, have industrial insurance coverage as verified by WA L&I, have an Employment Security Department number, have a WA state Excise Tax Registration Number, and must not be disqualified from bidding per the Debarred Contractors list. Successful bidder must have or shall obtain a Sedro-Woolley business license. Bidder shall register or maintain registration on the MRSC Consultant Roster at <http://www.mrscrosters.org> prior to award.

Bids are due by **2 pm on Thursday, February 15, 2018**.
