Our property at 1325 Pinto Lane, Sedro-Woolley, is directly across State Route 20 from the proposed Stabilization Campus, and we have concerns about the security of our persons and property. Staff recommendations for approval of the conditional-use permit included the following:

2. Sedro-Woolley Police and Fire shall not act as enforcement or treatment for patients. Facility must be staffed to support the level of care necessary for all patients accepted at the facility without reliance on the Sedro-Woolley Police or Fire Department for support or services other than those generally provided to all citizens (i.e., emergency calls). Facility must provide a staffing and level of services plan to the city for review and approval annually, no later than December 1st for the following year.

3. There shall be a written plan to address transportation for both new patients and released patients so as to prevent patients from simply walking in and out the front doors. This plan and any future changes to this plan must be approved by the Sedro-Woolley Police Department.

We feel it is imperative that those conditions be required and that we be included in the preparation of both of those plans since they will directly impact our security.

Another concern we have was shared in Exhibit H of the packet that alluded to the passage of deer from Hart Slough to the proposed Campus property. We would like to be assured that there will be sufficient space on the east end of the property to allow that to continue.
