

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT

City of Sedro-Woolley and AFSCME Local 176-SW

January 19, 2018

RE: Part-time yard waste attendant

The City of Sedro-Woolley and the Washington State Council of County and City Employees, American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, AFL-CIO, are party to a collective bargaining agreement (CBA) effective from January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2020.

The city has determined that the seasonal yard waste attendant is really better described as a part time position.

The CBA, Appendix A includes a wages for other part-time employees as agreed upon by MOU. The parties agree as follows:

The additional classification in Appendix A.1 is added under "hourly employees":


Yard Waste Attendant (P/T) Hourly 17.00-25.00

This position is not eligible for any benefits (other than Washington State Sick Leave).

This MOU shall not create a precedent for the purposes of collective bargaining.




