
RE: Take Home Vehicles

The City of Sedro-Woolley and the Sedro-Woolley Public Safety Guild, are party to a collective bargaining agreement (CBA) effective from January 1, 2017 through December 31, 2019.

Paragraph 12.2 of the CBA reads: "Police officers, sergeants and detectives are currently assigned one (1) vehicle per officer. Each assigned vehicle may be taken home when the officer lives within the Sedro-Woolley School District's boundaries and within a twenty (20) minute response time to the Sedro-Woolley Police Department Offices. Any officer living outside this boundary must leave his/her vehicle in an assigned parking space at the SWPD."

This agreement is intended to supplement the CBA as follows:

1. Paragraph 12.2 is expanded to allow officers, detectives and sergeants to live within a 25 mile radius from the Sedro-Woolley Police Department and within a 45 minute response time to be able to take home his or her patrol vehicle.
2. This expanded area shall be for a limited period of time as a pilot program, to allow for the evaluation of the effectiveness of the expanded area, ending on December 31, 2019, or sooner, at the Chief's discretion.
3. This agreement shall not establish a precedent for purposes of collective bargaining.
