## ADA Transition Plan Project Overview

- **Identify physical and communicative barriers** in City of Sedro-Woolley's public facilities that limit the accessibility of its programs, services or activities to individuals with disabilities;
- **Describe the methods** to be used to make the facilities, programs, services or activities accessible;
- **Provide a schedule** for making necessary modifications to provide better access and achieve compliance; and
- **Identify the public officials responsible** for implementation of the plan.

## ADA Advisory Group (AAG) Goals

- **Provide advice, identify accessibility barriers, and recommend accessibility improvements** to new and existing City programs, services and facilities as it relates to Title II of the ADA.
- **Develop relationships with other local organizations** serving individuals with disabilities as identified by the ADA.
- **Support City public engagement efforts** for the ADA Self-Evaluation and Transition Plan process including review of engagement tools and materials for accessibility.
- **May be asked** to support City staff on ADA Transition Plan implementation and future Plan updates.
