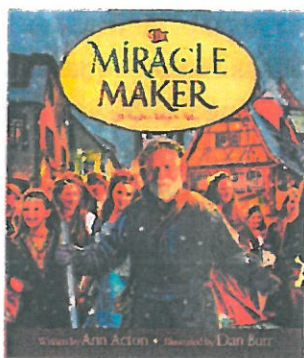

Authors, Terry Deighton and Ann Acton, will premiere their new holiday books and give short presentations on the author's journey in both traditional and self-publishing.

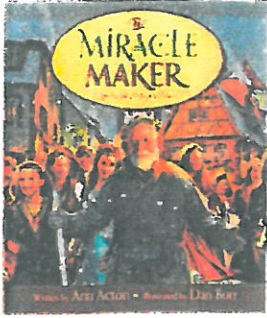

The Miracle Maker by Ann Acton

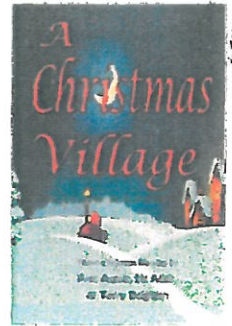

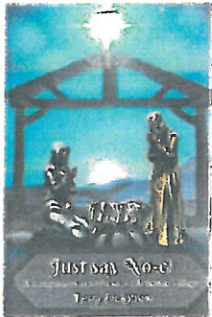
Now with stunning new illustrations, this special edition book is the perfect reminder that miracles can come in all shapes and sizes and sometimes from unexpected places.

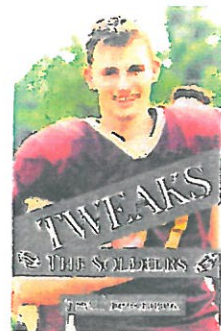
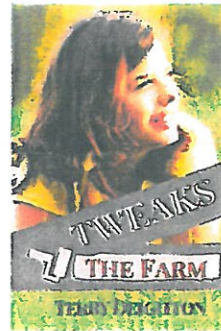
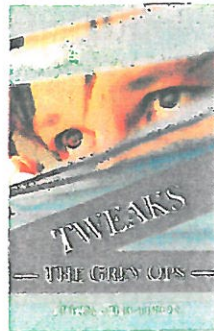
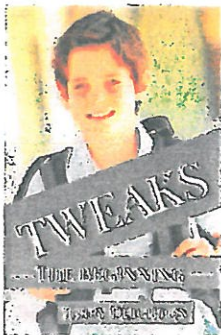


Just Say No-el by Terry Deighton is a companion novel to A Christmas Village.
