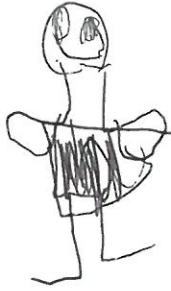

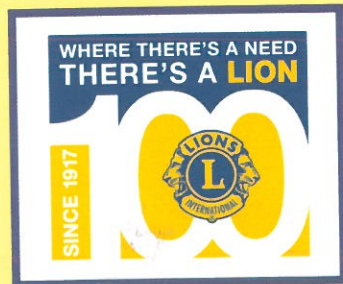

SCHOOLS

- 1937-40 donated flag and pole to Union High School, added lighting of the football field, supported building the vocational school.
- 1970, 2016 purchased band uniforms for SWHS
- 1976 first annual SWHS scholarships

PARKS

- 1940 planned childrens play park, later named Memorial Park
- 1941 construct bathing facilities at Clear Lake for Swimming school
- 1958 built kitchen and Bar-b-que at Memorial Park
- 1961 built Lions Roadside Park
- 1976 built Community Center with other service groups
- 1994 began work on SW playfields on Cook Rd. Now Janicki Fields
- 2002 Built Gazebo at Hammer Heritage Park

CITY

- 1943 built beds for emergency hospital at Catholic Church
- 1949 put up signs at city entrances
- 1950 agreed to manage 4th of July Loggerodeo Parade
- 2006 provided benches at UGH with Job Corps
- 2015 donated Lions Kitchen to city for Park Caretaker Residence

LIONS

- 1937 - now provide eye exams, glasses and hearing aids for those in need
- 1940-present provided Braille equipment, magnifiers, Guide dogs for blind citizens
- 2003 obtained \$10,000 LCIF grant for Hamilton flood victims
