

NEW Distracted Driving Law

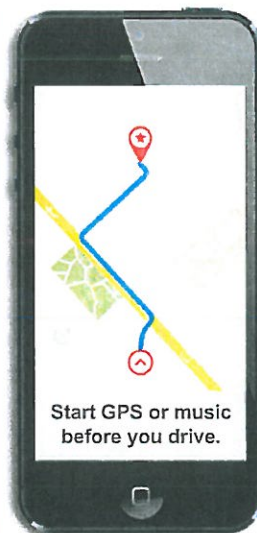
Effective July 23, 2017

No hand-held cell phone use while driving.

- Even when stopped in traffic or at traffic light
- Includes all electronic devices even tablets, laptops and video games
- No typing messages or accessing information
- No watching videos or using cameras

You CAN use your device if you are:

- Hands-free and can start use by a single touch or swipe of your finger
- Parked or out-of-the-flow of traffic
- Contacting emergency services



Fines:

Standard traffic fine of \$136.
Second offense:
Fine increases to \$234.

The ticket will be reported to your insurance company.

Dangerously Distracted:

You can get a \$99 ticket for other types of distraction such as grooming, smoking or eating, but only if you are pulled over for another traffic offense.
