At the corner of F & S and Garden of Eden Road there is a 5' deep ditch that runs through a large pipe and then crosses under F & S to continue out the south side. The shoulder of F & S along this ditch is almost non-existent. There is nothing to prevent a person from falling in. During the rainy season this ditch is filled with fast moving water. There is no guard in front of the pipe to prevent a person to be swept under the road and very likely drown. I have often seen children walking along here from school, riding bikes, joking and playing with each other next to this ditch.

Yet, just prior to this are two large drainage ponds with the required sloping and fencing that I believe the city maintains.

I see this ditch as a serious hazard. It might be expensive to fix, but much less so that a lawsuit over a preventable loss of life. I have noticed that the new round-about along highway nine has a grate preventing anything (or anyone) from going through.

This is something I have brought up before, but as the rainy season is coming up and nothing has yet been done, I want to bring it to the attention of the council again.
