The worksession was called to order by Mayor Wagoner at 7:00 P.M.

Flag Salute

CIAW – Sexual Harassment in the Workplace Training

- Mayor Wagoner turned the meeting over to Pat Flannery who provided the Council with a training titled Sexual Harassment in the Workplace. The training concluded at approximately 8:15 P.M.

Skagit Valley YMCA Funding Request

- Mayor Wagoner asked City Supervisor/Attorney Berg to address the proposed funding sources for the YMCA request that was tabled from the January 25, 2017 City Council meeting. Berg discussed the funding source for Fund 115 (*City Council Strategic Reserve*). Discussion among the Councilmembers and the Mayor followed. A question was asked about the timing of any possible payment and it was made clear that the request was for payments over five years.

Councilmember Kornegay moved to pledge \$30,000 to the Skagit Valley YMCA subject to negotiation and final approval of a contract. Seconded by Councilmember Kinzer.

Motion to amend the dollar amount in the motion on the floor to \$50,000 was made by Councilmember Johnson. Seconded by Councilmember Kornegay.

Motion to amend carried (5-2 Councilmember Owen and Kinzer opposed). Main motion carried (5-2, Councilmember Owen and Kinzer opposed).

- Councilmember Sandström asked about restricting funds in the future to use within the City.

- Councilmember Johnson asked a question for a neighbor about paving Talcott Street.
- A short discussion followed regarding priorities.

Councilmember Dunn Lee moved to adjourn. The Council adjourned without objection at 8:52. P.M.
