



## REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

### Bingham Park BBQ Pit Repair Project

The City of Sedro-Woolley is soliciting bids through our small works roster process for the repair of a wooden structure that provides cover to one of our BBQ areas at Bingham City Park, 340 Bingham Park Loop, Sedro-Woolley, WA

Instructions to Bidders: The referenced structure is made up of peeled logs, and was originally constructed in the early 1980's. Over the years the bottoms of the logs that have been in contact with the ground have begun to rot. The work will consist of bracing each post one at a time with temporary bracing, and removal of the rotten portion of each of the (8) support posts. Then a Sonotube will be used to pour new cement foundations for each of the support posts. Contractor will then attach the supports to the new foundations using support hardware. Please see attached photos.

City shall provide temporary fencing to protect the public from entering the structure during repairs.

Proposals shall include total costs including labor and materials, obtaining necessary licenses and permits (local and/or state), and all equipment necessary to safely complete the job, disposal of all related waste, and cleanup of the site.

Materials provided for this project will be per the current edition of the International Building Code, or equal to existing materials as appropriate. Work will be performed per the current edition of the International Building Code and City standards. See the attached Public Works Agreement for insurance, bonding, prevailing wage provisions and other provisions applicable to this contract. State prevailing wage rates per Washington State Department of Labor and Industries are required. Contractors must be registered contractors at time of bid, have a current UBI number, have industrial insurance coverage as verified by WA L&I, have an Employment Security Department number, have a WA state Excise Tax Registration Number, and must not be disqualified from bidding per the Debarred Contractors list. Successful bidder must have or shall obtain a Sedro-Woolley business license. Bidder shall register or maintain registration on our MRSC Small Works Roster Prior to award.

Bid Proposals are due by 2 pm on **Thursday, September 22, 2016**. Interested contractors are to provide a lump sum Bid Proposal and a Statement of Bidder's Qualifications including references utilizing the forms provided.
