REQUEST FOR STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS
PROFESSIONAL SERVICES SOLICITATION

The City of Sedro-Woolley is inviting statements of qualifications and performance information from firms interested in providing miscellaneous professional engineering support services for the **City of Sedro-Woolley Jameson Arterial Extension to SR9 (STPUS-7386(001))**. The city is self-performing the construction management work for this project, and is requesting proposals for support services including construction surveying and construction materials inspection and testing. Construction work for this project is scheduled for May through December 2016.

The surveying work includes construction surveying and monument documentation for the project. The geotechnical work consists of construction testing and documentation for the project.

The work to be performed under the construction contract consists of a 1,400-ft extension of Jameson Street and construction of a roundabout at the Jameson Street/SR9 intersection. Construction contract work includes: Temporary erosion and sediment control; roadway excavation; grading; stormwater drainage; HMA paving; illumination; signing; cement concrete curb, gutter and sidewalks and other work in accordance with the Contract Plans, Contract Provisions, and the WSDOT Standard Specifications.

Interested parties should respond with a Letter of Interest and Statement of Qualifications. Responses are due at the Public Works Director's office in Sedro-Woolley City Hall at 325 Metcalf Street, Sedro-Woolley, WA 98284 by **2 pm, April 1, 2016**.

Qualification and performance statements will be reviewed according to the City of Sedro-Woolley's Guidelines for Consultant Selection. Selection will be based on written responses only.
