



## INVITATION TO BID

### 2016 Klinger Street Bridge Shotcrete Project

The City of Sedro-Woolley is soliciting bids for the 2016 Klinger Street Bridge Shotcrete Project. The work will consist of applying shotcrete to stabilize rip rap bridge abutment support under one of our city owned bridge crossings of Brickyard Creek, as detailed in the Bid Proposal Form and Attachments.

Materials provided for individual projects will be per City of Sedro-Woolley Public Works Department Standards. Construction will be performed per the current edition of the Standard Specifications for Road, Bridge and Municipal Construction and City standards. The Bid Documents, Plans and addenda are available, at no charge, on-line at [www.ci.sedro-woolley.wa.us/BidsAwards/main](http://www.ci.sedro-woolley.wa.us/BidsAwards/main). Contractors who download these Bid Documents are responsible for insuring that they are added to the plan holder's list in order to receive any issued addenda. State prevailing wage rates per Washington State Department of Labor and Industries are required. Contractors must be registered contractors at time of bid, have a current UBI number, have industrial insurance coverage as verified by WA L&I, have an Employment Security Department number, have a WA state Excise Tax Registration Number, and must not be disqualified from bidding per the Debarred Contractors list. Successful bidder must have or shall obtain a Sedro-Woolley business license.

**Sealed proposals are due by 2 pm on Tuesday, September 13, 2016.** A formal bid opening will be held. Sealed proposals may be submitted in person or by U.S. Mail to: City of Sedro-Woolley, Public Works Department, 325 Metcalf Street, Sedro-Woolley, WA 98284. Results of the bid will be posted on the city website after award.

Interested contractors shall submit a completed Bid Proposal Form and a Statement of Bidder's Qualifications including references utilizing the forms available online.

All work is to be completed within **30 calendar days** of the Notice to Proceed.

Basis for selection will be lowest responsible bid as determined by a comparison of Bid Proposals received, a review of qualifications and references, and capacity to respond within the time frame stated.

The City of Sedro-Woolley reserves the right, without any liability on our part, to accept a proposal of the bidder submitting the lowest responsible bid, to reject any or all bids, revise or cancel the work to be performed, or do the work otherwise, if the best interest of the City is served thereby.
