### PROFESSIONAL SERVICES SOLICITATION

This project involves design of a new library or remodeling of an existing structure into a new library and will be completed in phases with an initial phase to commence immediately consisting of conceptual design and cost estimating, a second phase to commence dependent on funding to include full design of a new library and a final phase to include construction management to commence in the future.
