



## REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

### 2017 Arterial Street Crack Seal Project

The City of Sedro-Woolley is soliciting proposals through the small works roster process for crack sealing on 7 different city streets. The selected contractor shall provide labor, equipment and materials to perform the work as described below:

Instructions to Bidders: The contractor shall clean all Transverse, Reflective and Longitudinal cracks greater than 1/8" –inch in width with compressed air and shall be completely filled in with hot applied joint sealant asphalt emulsion crack seal. Total length of cracks to be cleaned and sealed is **approximately 30,000 LF**. Contractor shall be responsible for all traffic control on Cook Rd, including preparation of a traffic control plan for approval by the Sedro-Woolley Engineering Department. City will assist with traffic control and close streets as necessary to complete the other listed streets.

The locations are generally as follows. (See attached location map)

1. Metcalf Street from Northern Street to SR20
2. Ferry Street from Eastern Street to Township Street
3. Cook Road from City Limits to and including asphalt approaches to the Cook Road Roundabout (all four legs)
4. Township Street from Polte Road to Sterling Street
5. State Street from Maple Lane to Rita Street
6. State Street from Puget Street to Township Street
7. Portobello Street from Fruitdale Road to Cascadia Drive.

Proposals shall include total costs including freight, labor and materials, obtaining necessary licenses and permits (local and/or state), and all equipment necessary to safely complete the job, disposal of all related waste and cleanup of the site. Materials and Construction provided for this project will be per City of Sedro-Woolley Public Works Department Standards and the current edition of the Standard Specifications for Road, Bridge and Municipal Construction. State prevailing wage rates per Washington State Department of Labor and Industries are required. Contractors must be registered contractors at time of bid, have a current UBI number, have industrial insurance coverage as verified by WA L&I, have an Employment Security Department number, have a WA state Excise Tax Registration Number, and must not be disqualified from bidding per the Debarred Contractors list. Successful bidder must have or shall obtain a Sedro-Woolley business license. Bidder shall register or maintain registration on the MRSC Consultant Roster at <http://www.mrscrosters.org> prior to award.
