



INVITATION TO BID

2019 City Street Crack Seal Project

The City of Sedro-Woolley is soliciting bids through the small works roster process for crack sealing on eight different city streets, and two parking lots. The selected contractor shall provide labor, equipment and materials to perform the work as described below:

Instructions to Bidders:

The contractor shall clean all Transverse, Reflective and Longitudinal cracks greater than 1/8" – inch in width with the Hot Compressed Air Lance method. Cracks greater than 1/4" shall also be cleaned prior to hot compressed air cleaning with a mechanical wire brush. Cracks shall be completely filled in with hot applied joint sealant asphalt emulsion crack seal. "Crack Sealing" and "Crack Sealing with Routing" shall be performed in accordance with FHWA Technical briefing "Sealing and Filing Cracks in Asphalt Pavements," current edition. Crack Seal treatment material to be "Crafco Road Saver 543 Low Tack" or City approved equal. Total length of cracks to be cleaned and sealed is approximately 45,000 LF. Contractor shall be responsible for furnishing all traffic control. Traffic control plans to be approved by the City Engineer. City will assist with public notification on the affected streets, and will coordinate having vehicles removed from streets prior to the beginning of work.

***Engineers estimate for this project is \$50,000 to \$60,000**

1. Trail Rd
2. East State Street from Township to City Limits
3. Portobello St
4. Arezzo Dr
5. Vecchio Ct.
6. Cultus Mountain Dr.
7. Sauk Mountain Dr.
8. Round Mtn. Dr
9. Municipal Parking Lot corner of State St & Murdock Street
10. City Hall parking lot intersection of Munro St and Metcalf Street

Proposals shall include mobilization and demobilization, traffic control plans, traffic control, clean up and disposal of materials removed from cracks, labor, equipment and materials, sales tax, freight, all licenses, permits, fees etc. not otherwise specifically mentioned to safely complete the job.

Materials and Construction provided for this project will be per City of Sedro-Woolley Public Works Department Standards and the current edition of the Standard Specifications for Road, Bridge and Municipal Construction.

State prevailing wage rates per Washington State Department of Labor and Industries are required. For current rates in Skagit County use the following link: <https://fortress.wa.gov/lni/wagelookup/prvWagelookup.aspx> and use the bid close date as the effective date.

Bidders must be registered contractors at time of bid, have a current UBI number, have industrial insurance coverage as verified by WA Labor and Industries, have an Employment Security Department number, have a WA state Excise Tax Registration Number, and must not be disqualified from bidding per the Debarred Contractors list. If bidding on a public works project subject to the apprenticeship utilization requirements, must not have been found out of compliance by the WA State apprenticeship and training council for the one-year period immediately preceding the date of the bid solicitation. Bidders must have also received training on the requirements related public works and prevailing wage under RCW chapters 39.04.350 and 39.12. Bidders that have completed three or more public works projects and have had a valid business license in WA for three or more years are exempt from this training requirement. Bidders within the three-year period immediately preceding the date of the bid solicitation, may not have been determined by a final and binding citation and notice of assessment issued by the WA Labor and Industries or through a civil judgement entered by a court as defined in RCW 49.48.082.

Bidder shall register or maintain registration on MRSC Rosters at <http://www.mrscrosters.org> prior to award. Successful bidders must have or shall obtain a Sedro-Woolley business license at <http://bls.dor.wa.gov/cities/SedroWoolley.aspx> prior to any payment.

Proposals are due by **2 pm on Tuesday, March 12, 2019**. A formal bid opening will not be held. - A completed Bid Proposal form - acknowledging addendums on bid form (*if any*)
- Statement of Bidder's Qualifications - including references utilizing the form provided
- Certification of Compliance with Wage Payment Statutes – submit completed form within 24 hours of bid

The City of Sedro-Woolley reserves the right, without any liability on our part, to accept a proposal of the bidder submitting the lowest responsible bid, to reject any or all bids, revise or cancel the work to be performed, or do the work otherwise, if the best interest of the City is served thereby.
