



INVITATION FOR BID 2020 CITY STREET CRACK SEAL PROJECT

The City of Sedro-Woolley is soliciting bids under the city's Small Works Roster utilizing MRSC Rosters and the limited public works process for crack sealing on various city streets as identified below. The selected contractor shall provide labor, equipment and materials to perform the work as described below:

Instructions to Bidders: The contractor shall clean all Transverse, Reflective and Longitudinal cracks greater than 1/8" –inch in width with the Hot Compressed Air Lance method. Cracks greater than 1/4" shall also be cleaned prior to hot compressed air cleaning with a mechanical wire brush. Cracks shall be completely filled in with hot applied joint sealant asphalt emulsion crack seal. "Crack Sealing" and "Crack Sealing with Routing" shall be performed in accordance with FHWA Technical briefing "Sealing and Filing Cracks in Asphalt Pavements," current edition. Crack Seal treatment material to be "Crafco Road Saver 543 Low Tack" or City approved equal. Total length of cracks to be cleaned and sealed is approximately 30,000 LF. Contractor shall be responsible for furnishing all traffic control. Traffic control plans to be approved by the City Engineer. City will assist with public notification on the affected streets, and will coordinate having vehicles removed from streets prior to the beginning of work.

Engineers estimate for this project is \$30,000 to \$35,000

The locations are as follows listed by priority. * See attached location map

1. Klinger Street, Cook Road to F&S Grade Road
2. Rohrer Loop, Klinger Street to Klinger Street
3. Maple Lane, Sunset Drive to West State Street
4. North Fruitdale Road, SR20 to McGarigle Road
5. McGarigle Road, State Route 9 to North Fruitdale Road
6. Metcalf Street, Warner Street to Northern Street
7. 3rd Street, Sterling Street to State Street
8. State Street, Post Office Alley to 3rd Street
9. Township Street, Waldron Street to Polte Road
10. Murdock Street, State Route 20 to North limits (Contingency Project)

Proposals shall include mobilization and demobilization, traffic control plans, traffic control, clean up and disposal of materials removed from cracks, labor, equipment and materials, sales tax, freight, all licenses, permits, fees etc. not otherwise specifically mentioned to safely complete the job. Contingency project is not included in the base bid but may be added if funding is available.

Materials and Construction provided for this project will be per City of Sedro-Woolley Public Works Department Standards and the current edition of the Standard Specifications for Road, Bridge and Municipal Construction.

State prevailing wage rates per Washington State Department of Labor and Industries are required. For current rates in Skagit County use the following link: <https://fortress.wa.gov/lni/wagelookup/prvWagelookup.aspx> and use the bid close date as the effective date.

Bidder Responsibility Criteria: Bidders must be registered contractors at time of bid, have a current UBI number, have industrial insurance coverage as verified by WA Labor and Industries, have an Employment Security Department number, have a WA state Excise Tax Registration Number, and must not be disqualified from bidding per the Debarred Contractors list. If bidding on a public works project subject to the apprenticeship utilization requirements, must not have been found out of compliance by the WA State apprenticeship and training council for the one-year period immediately preceding the date of the bid solicitation. Bidders must have received training on the requirements related to public works and prevailing wage under RCW chapters 39.04.350 and 39.12. Bidders within the three-year period immediately preceding the date of the bid solicitation, may not have been determined by a final and binding citation and notice of assessment issued by the WA Labor and Industries or through a civil judgement entered by a court as defined in RCW 49.48.082, any provision of chapter 49.46, 49.48, or 49.52.

Bidders shall register or maintain registration on MRSC Rosters at <http://www.mrscrosters.org> prior to bid opening. Successful bidders must have or shall obtain a Sedro-Woolley business license at <https://dor.wa.gov/city-license-endorsements/sedro-woolley> prior to any payment.

Interested contractors are to submit, have completed, and registered **prior to bid opening:**

- **Proposal Form** utilizing the form provided
- A **Statement of Bidder's Qualifications** including references utilizing the form provided
- **Certification of Compliance with Wage Payment Statutes** utilizing the form provided
- Must have received training related to the public works and prevailing wage requirement or be exempt as verified by WA Labor and Industries (RCW 39.04.350(f))
- Registered on the City of Sedro-Woolley's **Small Works Roster** utilizing MRSC Rosters

Proposals are due by **2 pm on Tuesday, May 5, 2020**. A formal bid opening will not be held.
