



INVITATION FOR BID

2020 Cook Road Pump Station Rehab Project

The City of Sedro-Woolley is soliciting bids under the City's Small Works Roster utilizing MRSC Rosters for upgrades to our Cook Road Pump Station located at 1105 Cook Road, Sedro-Woolley, WA 98284

The project consists of removal and disposal of the existing submersible pumps, rails and discharge piping and the installation of new Grundfos Submersible Solids Handling Pumps Model SLV.40.A40.100.EX with 4-inch discharge including a Grundfos Auto Coupling Rail System complete with base elbows, pump guide brackets and guide rail brackets and 2-inch Sch. 40 304 stainless steel guide rail pipe and miscellaneous mounting hardware, Grundfos Pump Monitor Relay and power and control cables (approximately 50-feet for each pump – contractor to verify). The city will consider equivalent systems to the specified pump system. Alternatives must be approved prior to bid submittal. The installation shall include all labor and equipment and incidentals to provide a complete system, including disconnection and reconnection of power service and control wiring at the existing hand-hole, explosion proof sealing, mobilization and demobilization and start up. Contractor is responsible for all required safety measures to safely perform the work, including confined space entry requirements. Standard manufactures warranty is required.

Details on the condition of the existing pump station equipment along with photos is provided in the PumpTech "Sedro-Woolley Cook Rd Lift Station Report" dated 5/20/2020 included on the city website.

City forces will provide bypass pumping during the performance of the work. City will shut down and clean the pump station before start of work.

Contractor will schedule the work with the city and **complete the work within three consecutive working days.**

Work will be performed per the current edition of the International Building Code, National Electrical Code and City standards.

State prevailing wage rates per Washington State Department of Labor and Industries are required. For current rates in Skagit County use the following link: <https://secure.lni.wa.gov/wagelookup/> and use the bid close date as the effective date.

Bidders must be registered contractors at time of bid, have a current UBI number, have industrial insurance coverage as verified by WA Labor and Industries, have an Employment Security Department number, have a WA state Excise Tax Registration Number, and must not be disqualified from bidding per the Debarred Contractors list. If bidding on a public works project subject to the apprenticeship utilization requirements, must not have been found out of compliance by the WA State apprenticeship and training council for the one-year period immediately preceding

the date of the bid solicitation. Bidders must have received training on the requirements related to public works and prevailing wage under RCW chapters 39.04.350 and 39.12. Bidders within the three-year period immediately preceding the date of the bid solicitation, may not have been determined by a final and binding citation and notice of assessment issued by the WA Labor and Industries or through a civil judgement entered by a court as defined in RCW 49.48.082, and any provision of chapter 49.46, 49.48, or 49.52.

Bidders shall register or maintain registration on MRSC Rosters at <http://www.mrscrosters.org> prior to bid opening. Successful bidders must have or shall obtain a Sedro-Woolley business license at <https://dor.wa.gov/city-license-endorsements/sedro-woolley> prior to any payment. Successful bidders will also be required to submit a copy of their COVID-19 safety plan prior to their start date.

Proposals are due by 2 pm on Friday, October 16, 2020. A formal bid opening will not be held. - Must have received training related to the public works and prevailing wage requirement or be exempt as verified by WA Labor and Industries (RCW 39.04.350(f))
- Registered on the City of Sedro-Woolley's **Small Works Roster** utilizing MRSC Rosters
