



## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

### 2020 SR20 WEST LANE WIDENING AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Sealed bid proposals will be received by the City of Sedro-Woolley Public Works Department, 325 Metcalf Street, Sedro-Woolley, Washington, 98284 until **2:00 p.m., May 19, 2020**, at which time the bids will be opened and publicly read.

The project is located on SR 20 between Holtcamp Road on the west and Rhodes Road on the east in Sedro-Woolley. Work includes: widening SR20 on the north and south; installation of guardrail and non-flare terminals along the north and south sides of SR 20; full width 2" HMA overlay; restripe the roadway to provide for two through lanes and a two-way left turn lane; construct a new access across Brickyard Creek. The access includes installing 63 LF of 16'x6' bottomless aluminum box culvert with aluminum head and wing walls; install 250 LF 48-inch diameter storm pipe and fill an existing ditch on the north side of SR20. An in-line check valve will be installed in the end of the 48" pipe to serve as a fish barrier; erosion control; temporary traffic control; asphalt planning, mailbox and sign relocation; restoration and COVID-19 Health and Safety Plan (CHSP).

All work shall be done in accordance with the Special Provisions of the Bid Documents, the 2020 WSDOT Standard Specifications for Road, Bridge, and Municipal Construction, including the amendments thereto, City Standards and other referenced documents.

All bid proposals shall be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit in cash, certified check, cashier's check, or surety bond in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the amount of such bid proposal. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract within the time stated in the specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to the City of Sedro-Woolley.

A non-mandatory pre-bid meeting is scheduled **May 12, 2020, at 2:00 p.m.** Due to current conditions related to COVID-19, this will be an audio only meeting through GoToMeeting.
