



## INVITATION TO BID

### **2020 Unit Priced (On-Call) Electrical Services for Miscellaneous Electrical Services of an Emergent Nature**

The City of Sedro-Woolley is soliciting bids under the city's Small Works Roster utilizing MRSC Rosters and the limited public works process for a 12 month on-call electrical services agreement beginning on March 1, 2020.

Contractor shall provide electrical services to various City of Sedro-Woolley job sites including, but not limited to, the Wastewater Treatment Plant, Wastewater and Stormwater Pump Stations, City Hall, Fire and Police Building, Parks Shop, Solid Waste Shop, Street Shop, Cemetery Shop, Community Center, Senior Center and Library.

Electrical work may consist of, but not be limited to:

- Troubleshooting and repairing electrical issues with pumps, equipment, backup generators and UPS systems
- Troubleshooting and repairing electrical issues with sanitary sewer and stormwater pump stations, including float and ultrasonic control systems.
- Hard wiring new pumps or plant equipment
- Adding new electrical services
- Troubleshooting and repairing wiring, lighting and HVAC systems in City buildings
- Troubleshooting and repairing Street Lights

Electrical jobs will be scheduled by various City Department Heads on an as needed basis. Individual tasks will be assigned by Task Order. Scheduled Electrical services shall be performed Monday through Friday between the hours of 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM. There may be occasions when job completion runs beyond the normal working hours or when a Contractor is called in for an after hour's emergency. Contractors will respond within 1 hour during normal working hours and within 2 hours for after hour, weekend and holiday calls. The cumulative annual value of the work is estimated at \$20,000, but actual work will vary and no guarantee is made of the actual value of the work.

Materials provided for individual projects will be per the current edition of the National Electrical Code. Construction will be performed per the current edition of the National Electrical Code and City standards.

State prevailing wage rates per Washington State Department of Labor and Industries are required. For current rates in Skagit County use the following link: <https://fortress.wa.gov/lni/wagelookup/prvWwagelookup.aspx> and use the bid close date as the effective date.

Bidders must be registered contractors at time of bid, have a current UBI number, have industrial insurance coverage as verified by WA Labor and Industries, have an Employment Security Department number, have a WA state Excise Tax Registration Number, and must not be disqualified from bidding per the Debarred Contractors list. If bidding on a public works project

subject to the apprenticeship utilization requirements, must not have been found out of compliance by the WA State apprenticeship and training council for the one-year period immediately preceding the date of the bid solicitation. Bidders must have received training on the requirements related to public works and prevailing wage under RCW chapters 39.04.350 and 39.12. Bidders within the three-year period immediately preceding the date of the bid solicitation, may not have been determined by a final and binding citation and notice of assessment issued by the WA Labor and Industries or through a civil judgement entered by a court as defined in RCW 49.46, 49.48.082., or 49.52.

Bidders shall register or maintain registration on MRSC Rosters at <http://www.mrscrosters.org> prior to award. Successful bidders must have or shall obtain a Sedro-Woolley business license at <https://dor.wa.gov/city-license-endorsements/sedro-woolley> prior to any payment.

**Proposals are due by 2 pm on Tuesday, February 11, 2020.** A formal bid opening will not be held. Interested contractors are to provide:

- A **bid proposal** utilizing the form provided
- A **current rate sheet** including labor and equipment rates, mark-up rate for materials, estimated mobilization/demobilization cost for the sample project
- A **Statement of Bidder's Qualifications** including references utilizing the form provided
- **Certification of Compliance** with Wage Payment Statutes utilizing the form provided

Basis for selection will consist of comparison of proposals for man-hour, equipment rates and mobilization/demobilization costs per the attached sample project, a review of qualifications and references, and capacity to respond within the time frame stated. Based on responses received, a minimum of two contractors will be selected. Contracts will be awarded to selected contractors. It is anticipated that the lowest responsible bidder will be utilized for work under this contract, but should the primary contractor be unavailable, the work will be offered to the next contract holder according to the ranking of bids received.

The City of Sedro-Woolley reserves the right, without any liability on our part, to accept a proposal of the bidder submitting the lowest responsible bid, to reject any or all bids, revise or cancel the work to be performed, or do the work otherwise, if the best interest of the City is served thereby.
