



ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

2021 PAVEMENT AND PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Sealed bid proposals will be received by the City of Sedro-Woolley Public Works Department, 325 Metcalf Street, Sedro-Woolley, Washington, 98284 until **2:00 p.m., June 10, 2021**, at which time the bids will be opened and publicly read.

This contract provides for asphalt pavement overlays, as well as pedestrian improvements at various locations within the City of Sedro-Woolley. Overlay work consists of 2-inch HMA overlay on Wicker Road between Township Street and the City limits (approximately 1,185 ft) and Eastern Avenue between State Street and Ferry Street (approximately 650 ft). Overlay work will include planing, repairs to sections of roadway, placement of paving fabric and pavement markings. Pedestrian improvements include the removal and replacement of existing sidewalks and ramps, and constructing new ramps (12) and sidewalks. Other work elements include traffic control and adjusting existing structures.

This project is subject to all applicable Prevailing Wage statutes and regulations.

All work shall be done in accordance with the Special Provisions of the Bid Documents, the 2021 WSDOT Standard Specifications for Road, Bridge, and Municipal Construction, including the amendments thereto, City Standards and other referenced documents.

All bid proposals shall be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit in cash, certified check, cashier's check, or surety bond in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the amount of such bid proposal. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract within the time stated in the specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to the City of Sedro-Woolley.

A non-mandatory pre-bid meeting is scheduled **June 2, 2021, at 2:00 p.m.** Due to current conditions related to COVID-19, this meeting will be through Zoom Meeting.
